<b>Expected/achieved goals, activities, and results</b>	<p>The goal of this Operation is to separately collect biowaste and waste from the mixed fraction, through separate door-to-door collections in the residential and non-residential sectors, with a special focus on monitoring the collection processes.</p> <p>With this operation, LIPOR aims to see a significant increase in separate collection of materials for multimaterial recovery and composting, thus forming part of the guidelines of its municipal waste management activity set out in LIPOR's 2015-2020 Strategic Plan, focusing primarily on increasing multimaterial and biowaste separative collection, and hence contributing towards responding to its goals and targets set in PERSU 2020.</p>

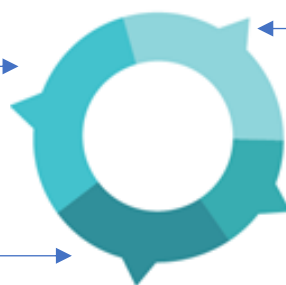
