



Expected/achieved goals, activities, and results	The objective of this Operation is to separately collect waste from the multimaterial fraction through selective door-to- door collections in the residential and non-residential sectors, and is based on fundamental awareness of the population.
	With this operation, LIPOR aims to see a significant increase in selective collection and in the recovery of materials for recycling, thus forming part of the guidelines of its municipal waste management activity set out in LIPOR's 2015-2020 Strategic Plan, primarily focusing on increasing multimaterial selective collection, and hence contributing towards responding to the goals and targets that were set in PERSU 2020.



The operation will allow an increase in the amount of waste, from the multimaterial fraction, which is recovered for recycling, significantly helping to meet the associated targets, namely the preparation for reuse and recycling target.











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
