

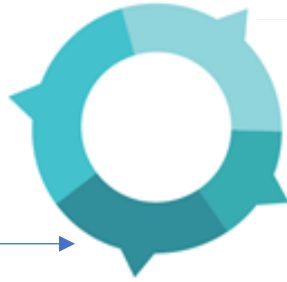

Expected/achieved goals, activities, and results	<p>The operation applied by LIPOR falls within the guidelines of its urban waste management activity defined in the LIPOR Strategic Plan 2015-2020 and in the LIPOR Strategic Plan already drawn up for 2021-2025 (v. May 2020). Its objective is to install a food waste microdigestion unit in Laúndos, Póvoa de Varzim, for the organic recovery of this type of waste, collected selectively, with a capacity to treat approximately 900 tons annually.</p> <p>The operation includes the following components:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Development of the project for the installation of equipment for receiving and preparing biowaste;- Supply and installation of equipment for receiving and preparing biowaste;- Supply and installation of a food waste microdigestion unit in Póvoa de Varzim.
